"Whereas ye know not what shall be on the morrow. For what is your life? It is even a vapour, that appeareth for a little time, and then vanisheth away" (James 4, 14).

In the first part of verse 14 we read, **"We know not what may be on the morrow"**. This pronouncement clearly states that the events of tomorrow are unknown to any man. Some naive persons resort to **"fortune tellers"** as they seek to see into tomorrow. Such so-called **"fortune tellers"** actually do NOT know what tomorrow may bring. In our day some resort to mystics and spiritualists who claim to be able to communicate with the unseen world. According to the text we must classify them as frauds, too.

To me, not to know all that may be on tomorrow is a blessing from the Lord. In the future there could well be some heart-ache. If so, I had rather not know. **Can you imagine the daily dread and horror if we knew all the valley experiences and heart-ache of the future?** It is an act of mercy and grace that tomorrow is not known.

On a Monday in 1951, I loaded my automobile to go away for a meeting in High Point, NC. On this trip my son wanted to go with me. So, we said goodbye to my wife and two daughters about noon-time and made the trip to High Point. I spoke on Monday night and Tuesday night and then Wednesday night. After the Wednesday night service I received a phone call from home that plunged me into the deepest valley of my life, a valley from which one never completely emerges. A drinking driver had plowed into the rear of my wife's automobile, killing my oldest daughter and seriously injuring my wife. I cannot place in words the

Perhaps you're someone who has difficulty in accepting the mercy and loving forgiveness of God, so freely. You think you must "do something" to receive eternal life. **"...but the GIFT of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord"** (Romans 6:23).

Indeed, the Holy Scriptures command us to do good works,

but NOT for our salvation. The Bible explains another twofold purpose for trying to be a good person.

First, the Bible says, **"...That they (other people) may see your good works, and glorify your Father, which is in Heaven"** (Matthew 5:16). Our good works are an external evidence of an internal change that has taken place in our hearts and it shows this to others through our born

He answers, **“It is even a vapour, that appeareth for a little time, and then vanisheth away.”**

All that James says is true. However, if life is only a vapor that soon vanishes

away forever, it would have been better had we never been born. We cannot deny the fact that life is fleeting. Neither can we deny the fact that it shall soon be over. The experiences of life prove this commentary. Life moves so swiftly. It seems as only yesterday when we were just children. The days of our sojourn are swifter than the weaver’s shuttle. Life, it is like a tale that has been told. Indeed, it is as a vanishing vapor. In many cases men die just as they get ready to live.

I attended the funeral of Dr. Bob Jones, Sr. As I sat in the great auditorium and looked at the casket in which his body rested; I cried in my soul, **“Lord, it does not seem to be right.”** I thought, he had just gotten the University built to the place where the job of training young people could really begin; then, he had to die...

So it is with many of God’s servants in every age. So it is with all flesh. Life is a vanishing vapor. In the light of the undeniable commentary of James upon life, I can only urge each of us to invest all we are in God’s ministry. At the very best life is only for a few short years. It will soon be over. The night is always at hand. The day is always far spent. We must buy up every open door of opportunity to minister and use it while we have time. **For what is your life? What are you doing for Christ?**

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But my dear friend, Paul knew that there is a Heaven and a Hell and so do I! You can be rich! You can own the most valuable possession offered unto man. The Bible refers to, **“Christ in You, the Hope of Glory”** (Colossians 1:27).

The Bible teaches, Zacchaeus did good works AFTER he was born again. "And Zacchaeus stood, and said unto the Lord; **Behold, Lord, the half of my goods I give to the poor;** and if I have taken any thing from any man by false accusation, I restore him fourfold" (Luke 19:8).



True Biblical salvation will change you at the precise point in time you become a Christian. The Apostle Paul received Christ as his personal Saviour on the road to Damascus (Acts 9:6) and his life was transformed on that very day. **Paul changed from persecuting Christians to praising Jesus Christ!** The Apostle Paul's life of good works following the various religious rules did not earn him a place in Heaven. It was the Apostle Paul's **BELIEVING IN JESUS CHRIST** when he knelt in prayer that **SECURED HIS FUTURE IN HEAVEN ABOVE!**

You must realize that you can never earn eternal life in Heaven yourself by being good, nor by following any religious practices. **You must be born again of the Spirit,** at that point in time when you bow your head and heart to God Almighty and call upon the name of the Lord Jesus Christ to save your soul. **"For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved"** (Romans 10:13).

Secondly, we must note that although we do not work to receive eternal life, there is another purpose or reason for obeying God's Word in doing good deeds and work. The Bible teaches that we will earn **ETERNAL REWARDS** based upon our faithfulness to God's will for our lives and our service to Him now. **"And, behold, I come quickly; and MY reward is with ME, to give every man according as his work shall be"** (Revelation 22:12).

"If any man's work abide which he hath built thereupon, he shall receive a reward. If any man's work shall be burned, he shall suffer loss: but he himself shall be saved; yet so as by fire" (1 Corinthians 3:14). Notice that you can be saved by faith and go to Heaven with little or no rewards simply by living a selfish life...

Then too, I must warn you that you can do good works and not go to Heaven! **"Many will say to Me IN THAT DAY, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in Thy name? and in Thy name have cast out devils? and in Thy name done many wonderful works? And then will I profess unto them, I NEVER KNEW YOU: depart from Me, ye that work iniquity"** (Matthew 7: 22,23).

"IN THAT DAY..."; This means JUDGMENT DAY, The Great White Throne Judgment. At that time when a person hears these words their opportunity to get eternal life shall be forever gone. Then they will realize the horror of being sent to Hell for eternity without any hope. It is so sad but true that God will reject **MANY people** because they placed their trust in themselves.

Sailing on the Sea of Life

"The east wind carrieth him away, and he departeth: and as a storm hurleth him out of his place" (Job 27:21).

On October 1, 2015 the U.S. cargo vessel "El Faro" went down in 15,000 feet of water just east of the Bahamas. The entire crew of 33 souls lost their lives. It is the greatest shipping tragedy involving a U.S. registered vessel in more than three decades.



According to official reports the ship was sailing full speed into the path of Hurricane Joaquin, a category 4 storm with 140 mph winds and 50 ft. waves. The ship deviated from its normal course and lost power leaving it at the mercy of the storm. A seasoned captain from a similar vessel said, **"A surprisingly small amount of water can cause this type of ship to capsize"**.

Experts assess that El Faro had three options that might have saved the ship: she could have slowed down and checked the weather, turned around and returned to port, or changed course to sail along the Florida coast, (a tactic she used in April to avoid Hurricane Erika). One

error in judgment caused the loss of the ship and all aboard.

Many today are sailing on the Sea of Life ignoring the storms until it is too late. They have passed the point of no return only to realize that they have no power and are at the mercy of the storm, ("and it only takes a small amount of water to sink our ship").

The disciples were caught in a great storm and knew that they could not handle it; **"And there arose a great storm of wind, and the waves beat into the ship, so that it was now full"** (Mark 4:37). They went to the Lord Jesus Christ, the One who can handle any and every storm that life can produce. "And He was in the hinder part of the ship, asleep on a pillow: and they awake Him, and say unto Him, **Master, carest thou not that we perish?** And He arose, and rebuked the wind, and said unto the sea, **Peace, be still.** And the wind ceased, and there was a great calm. And He said unto them, **Why are ye so fearful? how is it that ye have no faith?"** (Mark 4:38-40). Jesus was not disturbed by the storm but by their lack of faith.

Without the power of God we are at the mercy of the storms of life. Stop and assess the weather and change course before a point is reached from which the only end can be spiritual disaster. Don't lose your powerless vessel to life's storms but trust in Him who has all power to see you through; **"He maketh the storm a calm, so that the waves thereof are still."** (Psalm 107:29). — Fred Barton

Claiming Responsibility

As images of burning rubble and frantic people flash on the TV screen, a reporter says, **"A terrorist organization has claimed responsibility for last night's bombing that left 23 dead and scores injured."** It was not a random act of violence but one that was calculated to frighten people and advance the agenda of those who stepped forward to say, **"We did it."**



In stark contrast, one of history's most brutal acts was intended to bring peace and healing, not fear. **In addition, God claimed responsibility in the prophecy of Isaiah, seven centuries before it happened.** The prophet foretold the death of the Messiah in these words: **"But He**

was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon Him; and with His stripes we are healed... Yet it pleased the Lord to bruise Him; He hath put Him to grief" (Isaiah 53:5,10)

Just before Jesus Christ was crucified, He said, **"I lay down My life, that I might take it again. No man taketh it from Me, but I lay it down of Myself..."** (John 10:17, 18). "And while they abode in Galilee, Jesus said unto them, **The Son of man shall be betrayed into the hands of men: And they shall kill Him, and the third day He shall be raised again"** (Matthew 17:22-23).

Jesus died willingly for our sin so that we might live through faith in Him. God claimed responsibility for the death of His Son, allowing anyone to claim His gift of forgiveness. That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved

can know the truth if he will take Christ at His word and see what happens.

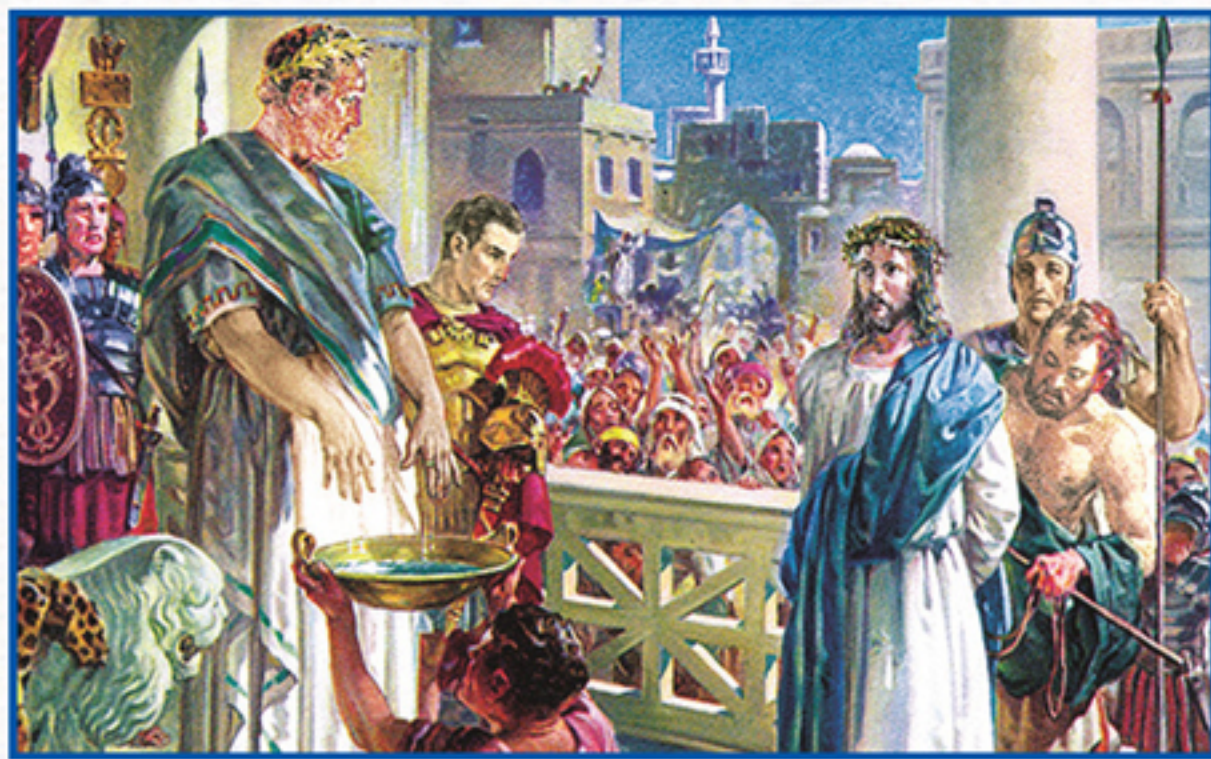

Learn that truth is not a "what" but a "Whom," and rest our souls on a Person, not upon a philosophy. Our Lord said, "Ye shall know the truth, and truth shall make you free" (John 8:32).

The secret of freedom is to know the truth, and the secret of truth is to know the Son. "If the Son therefore shall make you free, ye shall be free indeed" (John 8:36). The natural man cannot know the truth any more than a blind man can ap-

preciate a landscape, "for the natural man receiveth not the things of the Spirit of God". The heart has its reasons of which the reason knows nothing.

Truth is learned by believing, then seeing. The intellectual doubter is really only a moral coward who is not willing to give the Gospel a fair trial. **No one should criticize the Gospel until he has tried it; then he will not criticize it.** There are no reasons for being a cynic. There are excuses, but an excuse is only the skin of a reason stuffed with a lie.

The Lord Jesus Christ made a fair proposition. He said that willingness to obey God's will would prove the claims of Christ. Those who criticize the Gospel are not honest enough to try it on its own terms.



They are too ignorant to speak wisely about it, but not too wise to speak ignorantly. Let Christ prove Himself; He is His own defense. Come to Him as a sinner on His

terms, not yours. After all, we are not sinners because we are skeptics; we are skeptics because we are sinners. Skepticism is only a smokescreen thrown before a sinful heart. Instead of cynically asking, "What is truth?" Come to Him just as you are without one plea but that His blood was shed for you and He will prove Himself to be the answer. Jesus said, "...and him that cometh to Me I will in no wise cast out. And this is the will of Him that sent Me, that every one which seeth the Son, and believeth on Him, may have everlasting life: and I will raise him up at the last day" (John 6:37-40).

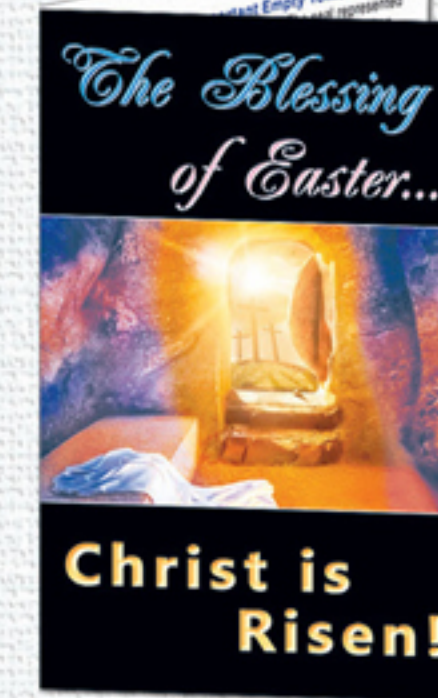
