## Lord, Remember Me

The thief on the other side of Jesus cried out, «**Lord, remember me when thou comest into thy kingdom**» (Luke 23:42). And in verse 43 Jesus said to him, «**Verily I say unto thee, To day shalt thou be with Me in paradise.**» This thief teaches us that even the most wicked sinner can be saved if he will only call on Christ and trust Him as Saviour. This thief teaches us that **none is beyond redemption, that none has waited too late.**

He wasn't saved because he was good. This man had no goodness to offer Christ. He was a thief and the worst kind of criminal. The very fact that he was being crucified indicated that.

Many religions teach that man is saved by his own good life. But we are reminded in Titus 3:5, «**Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy he saved us.**»

People say that you must be good to go to Heaven. **But no man goes to Heaven on his own goodness;** he goes on the goodness of God. The Bible says in Romans 10:4, «**For Christ is the end of the law for righteousness to every one that believeth.**» **You don't get better to get saved;** you get saved and then become a better person! Jesus did not come to save good people; He came



to save sinners.

Paul said in I Timothy 1:15, «**This is a faithful saying, and worthy of all acceptance, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners;** of whom I am chief.» This thief was saved despite the fact that he wasn't good. And his salvation teaches us one is saved by grace alone through faith alone.

He wasn't saved because he was a **member of the church.** This poor thief never

**Have you ever been so sure of yourself and then found out that you were wrong?** Certainly you have, we've all done that at one time or another.



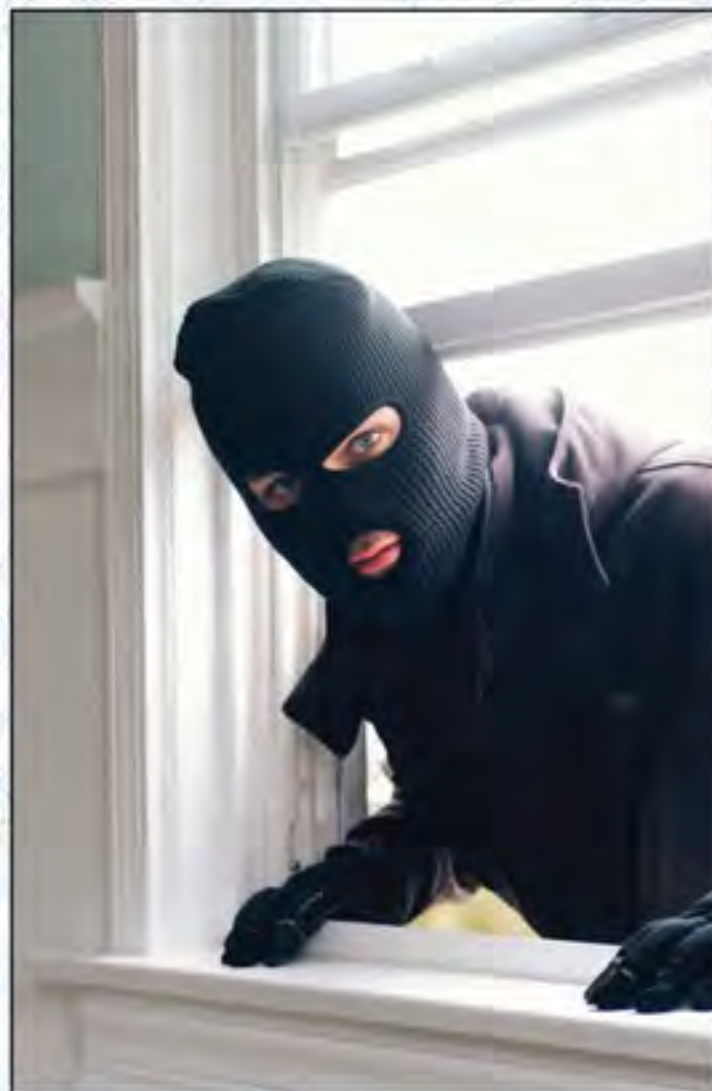

## Jesus Christ is Coming!

Many years ago I came home and discovered that a thief had broken into my house and took some of our possessions. I had no idea this was going to happen. I had no warning. I was unprepared, and we did not have any insurance to pay for our losses...

«**But know this, that if the goodman of the house had known in what watch the thief would come, he would have watched, and would not have suffered his house to be broken up. Therefore BE YE ALSO READY: FOR IN SUCH AN HOUR AS YE THINK NOT the Son of man cometh**» (Matthew 24:43,44).



«**...As the days of Noah were so shall also the coming of the Son of man be**» (Matt. 24:37). Let's examine this text.

### THE WICKEDNESS

The Bible tells us that Jesus Christ is coming again! **IN THE DAYS OF NOAH, «GOD saw that the WICKEDNESS of man was great in the earth...»** (Genesis 6:5). The Bible says that people's hearts were full of evil thoughts continuously, and describes a world of

ungodly people, living wild and selfish life-styles... «**The earth also was corrupt before God, and the earth was filled with violence**» (vs.11).

This sounds like our world today! People plan time for entertainment, recreation, sports, movies, sexual relationships and anything else for personal pleasure, but no time for God! Anything and everything, but God... **Our society has redefined the moral code of ethics for this generation.** We have justified abortion as «women's rights». We now have a multitude of «alternative life-styles» that have strayed from the traditional family unit. The anarchy, corruption of morals and disrespect for Christian values has grown at alarming rates. **Although the immorality problem is ignored by most people, the Lord Jesus Christ still says it is evil!**

Today, with modern technology people spend time at wild nightclubs, cinemas and watching TV, where you can view pornography and criminal violence presented as if it is acceptable behavior. Yet, at the same time much of the population plan their time

## A Faithful Witness

L.M. was a faithful man. His seat was occupied for every church service. His was a quiet presence as he worshiped. He did not pray in public, testify aloud, or very seldom say amen, but he loved the Lord. He is still missed in our church since his death several years ago. L.M. always kept his pocket full of gospel tracts. The tract rack at church needed to be filled constantly when he was there. He personally handed out tracts, left them in restaurants and phone booths, public restrooms, and when he went to a doctor's office he laid a tract in every seat in the waiting room. He explained that they have to pick it up in order to sit down. He just wanted it in their hand and trusted the Lord to do the rest.

When I asked him about his personal testimony while visiting in his home he shared this story. «I was at my job in the factory and a co-worker handed me a gospel tract. It made me mad and I told him so as I threw it down. I went back later and picked it up

and placed it in my pocket. Upon going home that day I found the tract in my pocket and read it. Under conviction, I threw it on top of the refrig-



erator and tried to forget it. I went back, picked it up and read it again. The Lord convicted my heart and I prayed to receive Christ right there in my kitchen. Since then I have been passing out tracts. If the Lord saved me through a tract He can save someone else the same way.»

This dear brother never preached a sermon, never sang a solo, never taught a Bible class, but only eternity will tell how many folks will be in Heaven because of his faithfulness to do what he could do for the Lord. Never underestimate the power of faith, prayer, and the written word in a gospel tract.

for financial success so they can fulfill their dreams... Searching for inner happiness, they buy new cars, new homes, "new toys", etc. This is understandable to a point. We all need money to live. We have basic needs..., but we shouldn't be just obsessed with material possessions!

**WHAT ABOUT GOD? WHO HAS TIME FOR GOD?** Do you think about the Lord Jesus as you go through your typical day? The Bible points out the error of focusing our desires on the things in this world. "Love not the world, neither the things that are in the world. If any man love the world, the love of the Father is not in him. For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world. And the world passeth away, and the lust thereof: but he that doeth the will of God abideth for ever" (1 John 2:15-17).

### THE WARNING

had time to join a church. When he died they took him down from the cross, rolled him into a ditch that had been prepared for his burial, and covered him with dirt.

Thousands of religious people say that you must belong to a church in order to be saved. Now everyone who trusts Christ as Saviour should join a good Bible-believing church and attend it faithfully. **But you don't join a church to get saved; you join a church after you have become saved.**



Dear friend, Jesus Christ is the Saviour, and He doesn't share it with anything or anyone. Many who have joined a church will not go to Heaven. Jesus said in Matthew 7:22, 23, **«Many will say to me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in thy name? and in thy name have cast out devils? and in thy name done many wonderful works? And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity.»**

Religion has never taken anybody to Heaven, but it has taken multitudes to Hell. A man might have good character; he may have good works; he may have membership in a good church; but if he doesn't have Jesus Christ, he doesn't have life according to I John 5:11, 12: **«And this is the record, that God hath given to us eternal life, and this life is in His Son. He that hath the Son hath life; and he that hath not the Son of God hath not life.»**

**The thief wasn't saved because he was baptized.** Jesus said to him, **«To day shalt thou be with me in paradise.»** In other words, **«I am going to take you to Heaven with Me today.»** Now let's face the facts. This thief was never baptized. If baptism were essential to salvation, Jesus would have said, **«I'm sorry but I cannot take you to Paradise unless we can get down off these crosses and I can baptize you.»**

God puts no condition or requirement on salvation that could possibly shut anyone

out. There is no condition in the Bible that any sinner on earth could not comply with and be saved instantly. The only condition is found in Acts 16:31, **«Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be saved.»**

He was saved because he saw himself as a sinner. In Luke 23:41, this penitent thief said, **«And we indeed justly; for we receive the due reward of our deeds: but this man hath done nothing amiss.»** With these words, this poor thief admitted that he was a sinner, that he was getting what he justly deserved.

One of the most difficult things to do is to get people to see they are sinners in need of a Saviour. Some will say, **«I live a good life.»** Still others, **«I'm a good father and a good husband.»** When I asked one man if he were sure he would go to Heaven when he died, he replied, **«Well, I'm not so bad.»** But Romans 3:10 tells us, **«There is none righteous, no, not one.»**

The thief was saved because he trusted Jesus Christ for salvation. This poor thief knew that he could not save himself, that Jesus Christ was his only hope of salvation, so he cried, **«Lord, remember me when thou comest into thy kingdom.»** No way could he promise to do better, for his life was coming to an end. His only hope was Jesus. And by the way, that was all he needed.

**It took great faith for that thief to believe that Jesus was God.** Remember both were hanging on a cross, and this poor thief was looking at a dying Jesus. But he trusted Him anyway. If this penitent thief could trust Christ, then how much easier it is for us to trust Him today!

We are living over 2,000 years this side of any empty tomb. The world has had over 2,000 years in which to witness and experience the saving power of a risen Christ. God saved this thief to show the world that Jesus will save anybody who will trust Him. One never gets too low nor too deep in sin. God means it when He says in Isaiah 1:18, **«Though your sins be as scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they be red like crimson, they shall be as wool.»**

But remember, two thieves were crucified with Christ. **One died rejecting Christ, and the other died trusting Him for salvation.** I Urge You to Trust Christ Today! You have seen that Jesus is willing to save the worst of sinners and that no one need despair. If you have never trusted Jesus Christ as Saviour, won't you call on Him today? In your own words tell Him that you know you're a sinner, that you believe He died for you, and that you are fully trusting Him to take you to Heaven when you die.

# Comfort in DEATH

**“While he yet spake, there came from the ruler of the synagogue’s house certain which said, Thy daughter is dead: why troublest thou the Master any further? As soon as Jesus heard the word that was spoken, he saith unto the ruler of the synagogue, Be not afraid, only believe”** (Mark 5:36).

Unless Jesus comes for us, we must all face that time of physical death. Jesus finally comes to the home of Jairus and is greeted with the word that his twelve-year-old daughter is dead. The servants said, **“Thy daughter is dead: why troublest thou the Master any further?”** (vs. 35). But notice the next precious word from our Lord: **“Be not afraid, only believe!”** (vs. 36). You see, death is no trouble to the Master, for He conquered Death, Hell and the grave for us! He is the Victor over Death, and so are all who have received Him as Saviour.



A twelve-year-old Christian girl was injured in an accident a few years ago. It didn't seem to be too serious. I went to the hospital late in the evening to see her and said, **“Martha, how are you feeling now?”** She answered, **“Not very good, pastor. Oh, but with Jesus I’m all right; other than that, I’m not very good.”** Yes, thank God, with Jesus it’s always all right for the child of God! I had prayer with the little girl and went home. The next morning I was surprised to hear that she had passed away

during the night. The hospital said evidently a blood clot had suddenly formed and she was gone.

I used for the funeral service this text from Mark, about the little twelve-year-old girl who had died; how it was no trouble at all to Jesus. I told the parents that this death of their precious one was no problem to Jesus, either; that He had just reached down from Glory and said, **“Come on home with Me, Martha. I need you up here in Heaven with Me now”**. I gave them the comforting thought that one blessed day He will again reach down from Glory and say, **“Damsel, I say unto thee, arise”** (vs. 41)!

Death is no problem to Christ, nor to the Christian. The body dies and goes back to the earth, and the soul and spirit of the child of God go to be with Jesus until the morning of the resurrection when He will raise from the grave a new, glorified, immortal body, fashioned after the likeness of His own! Should this present a problem to the child of God? **No!**

My friend, every problem you will ever face, from the cradle to the grave, falls under one of these five categories: **The problem of SIN. The problem of the HOME. The problem of POVERTY. The problem of SICKNESS. The problem of DEATH.** The only way you will ever be able to face these problems victoriously is by knowing Christ as your personal Saviour and by learning to trust Him in the midst of every trial. I do urge you to believe that Christ died for your sins, was buried and was raised again the third day, and that He will save you right now, if you will believe on Him. Then you will join the host of Christian folk who have learned to walk with Christ from earth to Glory, without fear of the problems of life.

# Jesus Preached About Hell

Jesus went beyond the deathbed when He told about the rich man who lifted up his eyes in Hell and saw Abraham afar off and Lazarus in his bosom; and the rich man cried, **“Father Abraham, have mercy on me, and send Lazarus, that he may dip the tip of his finger in water, and cool my tongue; for I am tormented in this flame”**



(Luke 16:24). There are a lot of worldly-minded ministers, and some of them are sentimental, who say that God is too good to send people to Hell, that His love precludes such a place as the Hell of the Bible.

I suppose they think they know more about love than He whose name is Love; more than He who so loved the world that He gave Himself to die on a cruel cross and endured the infinite wrath of a holy God!

I suppose they think they know more about love than He who was so filled with compassion that He cried to the weeping friends as He bore the heavy wooden cross on His lacerated back, **“Weep not for me, but weep for yourselves, and for your children”** (Luke 23:28).

I suppose they think they know more about love than Jesus, because Jesus said, **“Ye**

**serpents, ye generation of vipers, how can ye escape the damnation of Hell?”**

Jesus had more to say about Hell than anybody else in the Word of God. Of all of Jesus’ disciples, the one who wrote more about Hell was that disciple who is called **“the disciple of love,”** the Apostle John. Under divine inspiration, John wrote of the **“lake which burneth with fire and brimstone!”** (Revelation 21:8)

**AND ‘YE WOULD NOT!’**

After Jesus preached the hard words of Matthew 23, He turned around with a broken heart and, I believe with hot tears in His holy eyes, and cried, **“O Jerusalem, Jerusalem, thou that killest the prophets, and stonest them which are sent unto thee, how often would I have gathered thy children together, even as a hen gathereth her chickens under her wings, and ye would not!”**

**“I would ... but ye would not,”** He is saying. The Lord declares, **“Ye will not come to Me, that ye might have life”** (John 5:40).

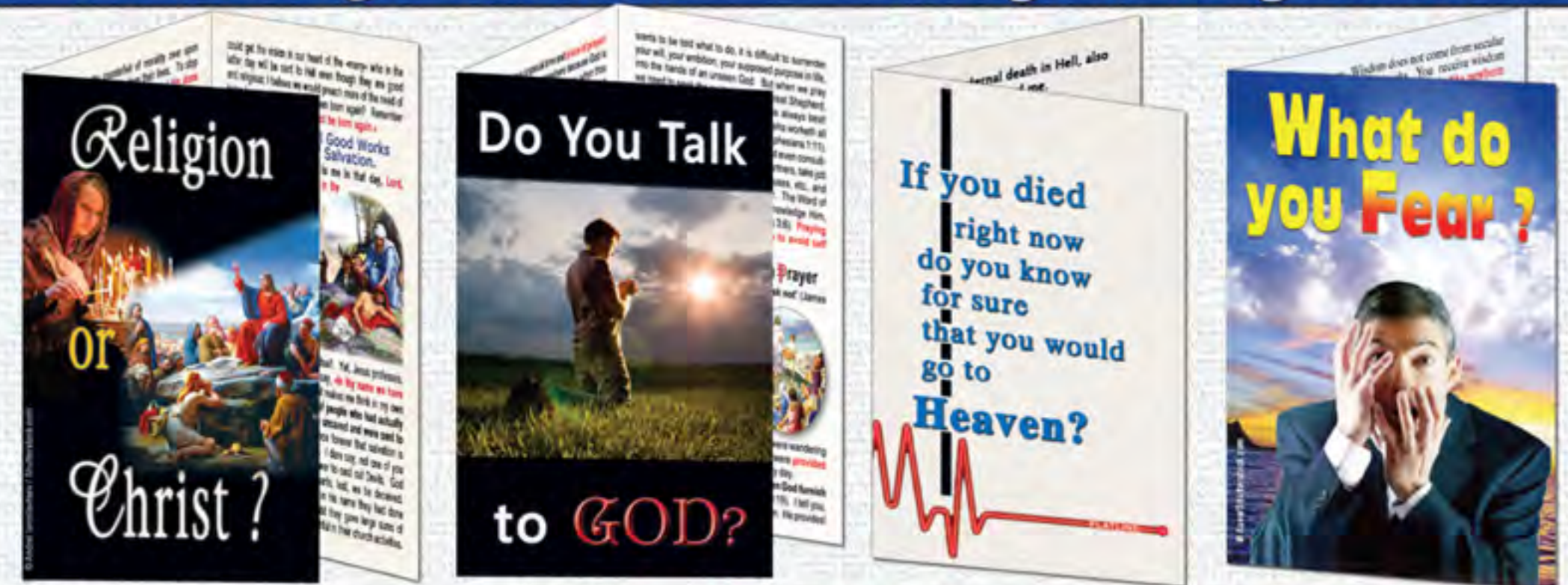
