Chaos, Perilous Times & Christ's Return!

Our world is obsessed with the pandemic crisis and the lack of peaceful coexistence among the various political points of view. Rather than have civilized debates on social issues we have protests and riots springing up around the world leading to chaos and anarchy. The Apostle Paul warns us in 2 Timothy 3:1 "This know also, that in the last days perilous times shall come." And he goes on to say, "But evil men and seducers shall wax worse and worse, deceiving, and being deceived" (Timothy 3:13).

These are indications of the soon return of the Lord Jesus Christ!

If you study eschatology, (the biblical study of end times prophecies) you'll read about Christ's warning, "And ye shall hear of wars and rumours of wars: see that ye be not troubled: for all these things must come to pass, but the end is not yet. For nation shall rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom: and there shall be famines, and pestilences, and earthquakes, in divers places" (Matthew 24:6,7). This text is actually



speaking prophetically about the events **after the Lord removes** His church body of believers, called the "rapture" and then begins the Tribulation period on earth. Biblical prophetic signs are for Israel...

However, I personally believe these things listed will not suddenly arise after some utopian world bubble is burst. **It's not as if the world will be in peaceful harmony and then the Church rapture occurs, leaving a vacuum for wars and rumors of wars to arise, or the**

pestilences and earthquakes to suddenly appear. No, I'm persuaded that we are seeing a precursor happening now as the church age is closing. We can discern a coming storm from the gathering clouds... The warnings Christ gave us are indicators in a minor form of that which is to come after His sudden appearing! First, the believing Church must be removed and then God focuses His judgment on Israel! The "indicators" become signs for Israel as they are magnified beyond measure and intensify...

Searched the Scriptures...

«They received the Word with all readiness of mind, and searched the Scriptures daily, whether those things were so. Therefore many of them believed; also of honourable women which were Greeks, and of men, not a few» (Acts 17:11,12)

These people, heard the message and then "searched the Scriptures" to see whether or not Paul had spoken the truth. The person who hears and recognizes the truth of the Scriptures - but rejects that truth - is inviting the judgment of God. The Jews have paid a tremendous price for resisting the truth. Their minds have been blind for two thousand years, and the vast majority of them are still willingly ignorant concerning the fulfillment of the prophecies of their Old Testament Scriptures.

But the Bereans were of a different moral and mental character. They did not resist the Word. On the contrary they heard Paul's message, they allowed him to bear testimony which was directly

against everything they had been taught, and then they searched the Scriptures to prove whether or not the roots of that message were founded in the truth of God.

Notice one thing here: This verse does not tell us that the Bereans simply read the Scriptures. They **SEARCHED** - and they searched **DAILY**. It is one thing to read the Bible, it is altogether another thing to search the Scriptures, to dig deep into the Word of God and pray for the Holy Spirit to give you light

I am thinking of the contact that was made. I read that "when he was come out of the ship, immediately there MET Him... a man." Some people meet folks who are not good for them to meet. It was a terrible thing for Anthony to meet Cleopatra, the beautiful adder coiled upon the throne of the Ptolemies for whom he basely forsook the battle of Actium.

It was a terrible thing for Samson when he met Delilah. It has been a terrible thing for many people when they have met some other people in whom the Spirit of God was

not. But it was a glorious thing for this man to meet Jesus. "And when He was come out of the ship, immediately there met Him . . . a man." Here was darkness meeting light. Here was pollution meeting God's purity. Here was devilment meeting divinity. Here was one from tombs of earth meeting one from the throne of Heaven.

He did not run away from Jesus; he came to Jesus! And here you see another consternation, one that makes you to be filled with reverent awe. You see one who had made all others afraid now himself afraid-afraid of Jesus. He said, "What have I to do with Thee, Jesus, thou Son of the most high God? I adjure Thee by God, that Thou torment me not." The man possessed of this evil spirit naturally looked upon Jesus as a tormentor-and he was afraid of Jesus. That is the attitude of every natural man toward Jesus always. Many today seem to think that Christianity is a kill-joy and that if you become a Christian you must wear a long face, and go around with clogs on

your feet and dress up in sackcloth and carry a bag of ashes and put them on your head ever and anon. What a false conception that is of Christianity! Many seem to imagine that to become a follower of Jesus means to leave behind everything in life that is pleasant and of value. They seem to have no ears for Paul the apostle who said, "Rejoice . . . and again I say, Rejoice." They seem to be deaf to the significance of the teaching of Jesus in John 15:11 where He says, "These things have I spoken unto you that my joy might remain in you, and that your joy might be full." Does that sound like a life of misery? I think not!

THE COMMAND - "Come Out of the Man"

We notice that after this contact, after this wild man met Jesus, there was a command. Jesus said unto the devils, "Come out of the man." And they came out. The One who touched blind eyes and made them see; the One who touched deaf ears and made them hear; the One who touched twisted limbs and

A Prayer Example for Believers

“And there were also two other, malefactors, led with Him to be put to death. And when they were come to the place, which is called Calvary, there they crucified Him, and the malefactors, one on the right hand, and the other on the left. Then said Jesus, Father, forgive them; for they know not what they do...” (Luke 22:32-34).

When Jesus' hands could no longer perform acts of mercy because they were nailed to the cross, when His feet could no longer go on errands of mercy because they were held by a spike, when He could no longer instruct His apostles because they had fled, what did He do? He prayed. What a lesson for every believer!

Sometimes people, as they get older and health prevents them from being as active in the service of the Lord as they once were, have a tendency to let up. But wait a minute. You may be so weak that you cannot attend the public services; you may be so weak that you cannot go on soul-winning visitation; you may be so weak that you cannot work and make money to give as the offering is received - but you can pray! There is not a member of the body of Christ who cannot pray.

In Isaiah 59:16 the Bible says God **“wondered that there was no intercessor.”** Imagine, God Almighty in Heaven wondering that there is no intercessor! The greatest ministry a man can

perform is the ministry of prayer. That is the present ministry of our Lord. Hebrews 7:25 says, **“He ever liveth to make intercession ...”** He is praying this very hour. What a lesson for us!



But Calvary was not the place to pray. Gethsemane was the quiet garden. Gethsemane was the place with no distraction. There was the place to pray, not Calvary.

See the mob as they gather around the foot of the cross. Hear them as they jeer at Him. **“If He is God, let Him come down! If He is the Son of God, let Him**

save Himself! He saved others; let Him save Himself!” Can't you almost hear the jeering and howling of the mob? Hear also the cursing of the thieves, one on either side, who were crucified with Him. And amidst all this, Jesus prayed.

David Smith said, “It was usual for the victims of that dread doom, frenzied with pain, to shriek, curse and spit at the spectators.” But not Jesus. Rather than pronouncing doom and shrieking and cursing and spitting at the spectators, Jesus cried, **“Father, forgive them; for they know not what they do.”** There is an example for believers.

Dr. A. J. Gordon said, “There is more you can do after you pray, but there is nothing you can do until you pray.”

Adopted

In ancient Rome, adoption was occasionally used by the emperors to pass on succession to competent heirs. Augustus Caesar was adopted by his great-uncle Julius Caesar. Other notable adoptees include the emperors Tiberius, Trajan, and Hadrian. All of them proved to be strong rulers because each lived like a child of his adoptive father.

Every Christian is an adopted child of the King of kings. We are greatly indebted to Him for His favor. But God, who has everything, does not need us to repay Him. **“For ye have not received the spirit of bondage again**

to fear; but ye have received the Spirit of adoption, whereby we cry, Abba, Father” (Romans 8:15).

What does God desire? He wants us to live in a way that befits His children. Activi-



ties and values that are not in keeping with our position as God's children must be done away with. **“Mortify therefore your members which are upon the earth; fornication, uncleanness, inordinate affection, evil concu-**

piscence, and covetousness, which is idolatry” (Colossians 3:5). Selfish and destructive ways are to be replaced by activities and values that showcase our gratitude and love for God and reflect our status as His children. Paul wrote, **“Put on therefore, as the elect of God, holy and beloved, bowels of mercies, kindness, humbleness of mind, meekness, longsuffering”** (v.12).

Can others around you tell that you are indeed a child of the King? Ask the Holy Spirit what you need to put off and put on in your life so that you can reflect more truly your status as God's adopted child.

No one has all the answers about the end of times. Jesus said, **“But of that day and hour knoweth no man, no, not the angels of Heaven, but My Father only”** (Matthew 24:36). Yet we do know certain facts! We know that our world has changed through the centuries. **“Wars and rumors of wars...”** Obviously the weapons of warfare have changed considerably since the ancient era of Alexander the Great. However, today, the young and old alike fear the possible catastrophe if a major war with modern technological warfare should break... We pray this will be avoided! (*Greece & Turkey today i.e.*)

Let me remind you of another Biblical fact. Our world has an appointment with God's wrath, when the earth shall be totally destroyed! Just as we avoid the negative fears about a painful appointment with our dentist, we also reject the negative thought of our world as we know it coming to an end! Study carefully 2 Peter and chapter

3, you will learn that, **“... in the last days... people will say that all things will continue as they were from the beginning of the creation.”** (vs. 3,4) Peter warns us saying, **“But the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night; in the which the Heavens will pass away with a great noise, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat, the Earth also... shall be burned up”** (vs. 10).

But born again believing Christians are not to live in fear, rather rest in God's peace with comfort. Living a life of godliness that will produce eternal benefits. The Apostle Peter goes on to assure the believers with God's promise of a **“new Heavens and new Earth”** (vs. 13). Know that this destruction of the earth by fire is nothing for the Believer to fear! The New Earth is an expression used in the Book of Isaiah, 2 Peter, and the Book of Revelation in the Bible to describe the **FINAL STATE** of all redeemed humanity.

A simple outline form of God's plan is revealed to us in the Holy Scriptures. First,

Don't You See It?

“When Simon Peter saw it, he fell down at Jesus' knees, saying, Depart from me; for I am a sinful man, O Lord” (Luke 5: 8).

Suddenly, he realized that Jesus was the LORD God! This was salvation. Peter said, **“Depart from me; for I am a sinful man, O Lord”**. We see him acknowledging the Lordship of Christ. He heard the preaching of the Word of God. Then he experienced the hand of Almighty God providing him with so many fish. This brought Peter to suddenly see the reality of Christ's divinity and of eternal life through believing on Him!

Do you remember playing as a child with a picture jigsaw puzzle? Slowly one by one you put the pieces together... There it is, right in front of

Christ will return at an unknown instant to take those who have placed their faith in Him, to Heaven. **“The dead in Christ shall rise first, then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up... to meet the Lord in the air...”** (1 Thess. 4:16,17). Who Signed Your Check?

“Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven. Many will say to me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in thy name? and in thy name have cast out devils? and in thy name done many wonderful works? And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity.” (Matthew 7:21-23)

The State of Rhode Island recently issued more than 175 tax refund checks signed by Walt Disney and Mickey Mouse. The Rhode Island Division of Taxation uses the signatures on test files but they were mistakenly printed on the real checks and sent out to taxpayers awaiting their refunds. Can you imagine receiving a genuine, bona fide government check with everything in order only to discover that it was signed by Mickey Mouse? What an embarrassment when the cashier at the bank points out that the check is worthless.



There are church folks today who believe that they have got the real thing; salvation and a home in Heaven await them because they received something that looks bona fide and genuine but is in actuality signed by a make believe character. It is certainly a matter for much caution because sadly by the time the fake signature is noticed it will be too late. It might look like the real thing but it is worthless.

These people that our Lord spoke of in this passage thought that they were alright. They

even begin to remind Jesus of all of the wonderful religious activities that they had been part of. The Lord not only says **“I never knew you”** but also states that all of their activity has been sin and not what they thought it was at all. They failed to look at the “signature” on their check.

How can I be sure that I am saved and my “check” has the right “signature”? The Bible gives us direction. First and foremost is **“Have I received Christ as my Savior?”**; **“That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord**

Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved.” (Romans 10:9). Secondly, **“Does the Holy Spirit dwell in my heart?”**; **“The Spirit**

itself beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God:” (Romans 8:16). If these two things are present in your life then the Bible gives assurance of salvation; **“These things have I written unto you that believe on the name of the Son of God; that ye may know that ye have eternal life, and that ye may believe on the name of the Son of God.”** (I John 5:13).

Let me encourage you to take a minute and look at the “signature” on your “check”; **“Wherefore the rather, brethren, give diligence to make your calling and election sure: for if ye do these things, ye shall never fall:”** (II Peter 1:10). Be sure it is signed by the Lord Jesus Christ and not some spiritual “Mickey Mouse”.

made them walk; the One who touched twisted, withered hands and made them whole; the One who touched lepers and made them clean; the One who touched crazy men and restored their reason; the One who touched dead people and restored them to life—that same One gave a command to the devils in the man, and they came out. The One who hushed storms into peace on Lake Galilee hushed the storm in this poor man’s heart, in this wretched man’s interior. Christ gave command and the devils gave up their habitation in this man!

Our Lord’s power over the Devil is something that ought to cheer us greatly! Without our knowledge of His power over the Devil we might sometimes well despair about our salvation, about our victory, and about Heaven. To know that we have an invisible spiritual enemy near us who will trip us up and bind us and blind us and lead us into wrong paths and into wrong places; to know that we have one who is laboring night and day for our destruction, would be enough to crush out every hope if we did not know that we have a Protector about whom we can say:

Jesus is stronger than the strongest. He is stronger than the armed man who is ever warring against our souls. We can look to Jesus and say, **“Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword?... Nay, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him that loved us.”**

THE CHANGE -“Sitting . . . Clothed, and in His Right Mind”

Notice the change. **“They come to Jesus, and see him that was possessed with the devils, and had the legion, sitting, and clothed and in his right mind.”** There is the change, isn’t it? And what a glorious change it is! There was a change in body. His body was no longer a habitation of devils. There was a change in mind. His spirit had been regenerated. **“Sitting,”** not running around wildly. Completely cured. **“At the feet of Jesus.”** No longer an inhabitant of tombs. Clothed—no longer naked. Quiet—not quarrelsome. Calm—not crazy. The stormy sea is



a calm. The cyclone has died to a whisper. The thorny hedge has changed to a fruitful bough. The snarling mouth has been filled with praise. The clenched fist is now an open palm. The eyes of fury are now eyes of faith. The heart that was a council chamber of devils is now a throne room of angels. The fettered man is now the free man. The fierce fiend has become a gentle friend. The chained one is now chainless. The frowning and fretful one is now the smiling one. What a change!

But listen to me! Of all the changes you can think of in this world today, or any day, is the change which the regenerating grace of Christ brings into human lives, when the vicious are made virtuous, when drunkards are made sober, when harlots are made pure, when liars are made truthful, when thieves are made honest, and intellectual skeptics are made humble, when follies are taken out and wisdom put in. Oh, the greatest change you will ever see in this world is the change which the regenerating grace of Christ brings in human lives when foul mouths are made clean; when tongues instead of dripping acid and vinegar, drip with honey; when weak folks in the things of the spirit are made strong in spiritual things for Christ Jesus. What a change, since Jesus came into my heart!

and understanding. Reading may bring knowledge, but to know God's will and grow in wisdom we must search, and our searching must be of such quality as the Bible recommends.

Hear the words of Solomon in Proverbs 2:1-5, «My son, if thou wilt receive my words, and hide my commandments with thee; so that thou incline thine ear unto wisdom, and apply thine heart to understanding yea, if thou criest after knowledge, and liftest up thy voice for understanding; if thou seekest her as silver, and searchest for her as for hid treasures; then shalt thou understand the fear of the Lord, and find the knowledge of God!»

The Bereans searched the Scriptures - not for the sake of material for argument, BUT TO LEARN «whether those things were so». Imagine, the people of Berea who were accustomed to Holy Tradition and the teaching of the religious leaders were hearing Paul preach a «new» message about Jesus Christ. The answer they sought was to discover if Paul and Silas were preaching the truth! Was this new teaching in harmony with the Old Testament prophecies? **If so, then they would receive it!** If not, they would reject it... This is the wise thing for believers to do today. We should compare the preaching we hear from the pulpit with what God's Word has to say. This is the priesthood of the believer.

Doctrine should be examined in the light of the Scripture, and «if there come any unto you, and bring not this doctrine, receive him not into your house, neither bid him God speed: for he that biddeth him God speed is partaker of his evil deeds» (2 John 7-11 in part). Believers should not give comfort or aid to the enemies of the Gospel; and those who do so will lose their reward at the end of life's journey - yes, even if they have been born again. You will note I said they will lose their reward - not their salvation.

«**THEREFORE many of them believed.**» It is just as true today as in the days of Paul that those who diligently search the Scriptures for truth will eventually believe, because the Word of God will convince any sincere seeker of truth. The Word of God is the living Word. It is light, and the entrance of light brings life. Faith to be saved comes by hearing, and hearing comes by the Word of God.

Jesus declared, «**Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that heareth my Word, and believeth on Him that sent me, hath everlasting life, and shall not come into condemnation; but is passed from death unto life**» (John 5:24). Jesus also said, «**It is the Spirit that quickeneth; the flesh profiteth nothing: the WORDS that I speak unto you, they are spirit, and they are LIFE**» (John 6:63). The Word of God is the incorruptible seed that brings eternal life through the new birth.

The Bereans searched the Word daily, and as a result of their sincere searching many of them believed. We do not know how many believed, but we are told that among them were «**honourable women which were Greeks, and of men, not a few**». How about you? Have you searched the Scriptures or do you just follow the opinions of others? «**Search the Scriptures; for in them ye think ye have eternal life: and they are they which testify of Me**» (John 5:39). — Tom Meador

Search and Rescue

The Son of Man has come to seek and to save that which was lost. — Luke 19:10

Almost every week we see news about a search-and-rescue mission. It may involve a child who wandered away from a family picnic and is lost, or a hiker stranded on a mountain, or people trapped in the rubble following an earthquake. In every case, the people at risk are unable to help themselves. Those who are found and saved usually have lasting gratitude for those who joined in the search and rescued them.

The account of Zacchaeus in Luke 19:1-10 is a story of search and rescue. At first glance it may seem like a series of chance events—Jesus was passing through Jericho and a rich tax collector climbed a tree to catch a glimpse of the miracle-working teacher. But this encoun-



ter with Jesus was not a coincidence. At the end of the narrative, Luke deliberately included Jesus' words to Zacchaeus, «**Today salvation has come to this house . . . ; for the Son of Man has come to seek and to save that which was lost**» (vv.9-10).

Jesus began His search-and-rescue operation on earth by His life, death, and resurrection. He continues it today through the power of the Holy Spirit, and He graciously invites us to participate with Him by loving those who are lost.

Hard To Imagine



For I am in a strait betwixt two, having a desire to depart, and to be with Christ; which is far better: (Philippians 1:23).

Whenever my wife and I get ready for a vacation, we like to read about our destination, study the maps, and anticipate the joy of finally arriving at the place we've dreamed about for so long!

I think the most profound description of Heaven is found in Paul's words to the Philippians. He said that to «**depart and be with Christ**» is «**far better**» (Phil. 1:23).

It's what I told my 8-year-old grandson when he asked what Heaven is like. I started by asking him, «**What is the most exciting thing in your life?**» He told me about his computer game and other fun things he likes to do, and then I told him that Heaven is far better! He thought for a minute, and said, «**Grandapa, that's hard to imagine.**»

What is it that you look forward to in life? What really excites you? Whatever it is, although it's hard to imagine, Heaven will be far better!
