

Can You Know FOR SURE




that you will go to HEAVEN?

CAN YOU KNOW FOR SURE THAT YOU WILL GO TO HEAVEN?

I could ask you a host of questions. Are you married or single? Male or female? Do you own a car? Do you go to church? Have you ever been to jail? Your reply would be instant. But sadly, when many are asked about their eternal destiny, (*Heaven or Hell*) they say that no one can know for certain or that they hope so...

However the Word of God teaches us that we can be sure about Heaven! **“These things have I written unto you that you may KNOW that ye have eternal life...”**



(1 John 5:13). God is not a liar and He has never intended for man to go through life guessing and wondering about such an important issue. The Bible does NOT say, “maybe” or “we’ll see”, but **“THAT YE MAY KNOW THAT YE HAVE ETERNAL LIFE...”** The Apostle Paul was convinced in his heart he was Heaven-bound

and that is why he said “...to die is gain” (Phil. 1:21).
